

## Tim Hagan Area 7 Director Lead Measurements Engineer, JT4 LLC (Ret)

Tim retired in 2019 from JT4, LLC, after a career mostly in radar systems and Electronic Warfare. At JT4, he was a Lead Measurements Engineer in the testing and measurement of radar systems. After graduating from UMR, Tim worked as an Engineer in radar design for General Dynamics, Fort Worth Division. At Northrop he was a Senior Engineer in the design, integration, and testing of an electronic countermeasure for the B-2 Bomber. At INTELSAT, he worked as an Integration & Test Engineer on a communications satellite. Tim has also worked with EG&G Technical Services in Las Vegas, where he was an Engineering Specialist integrating radar systems onto a test and training range. He was transferred to JT3, LLC, a joint venture of EG&G and Raytheon, and then to JT4, LLC.

Tim earned his bachelor's degree in electrical engineering in 1983 at the University of Missouri-Rolla (now Missouri S&T) and then earned a master's degree from Georgia Institute of Technology in 1993.

Tim is active with the Libertarian Party. He has been the Treasurer of the Libertarian National Committee since 2012. He has served as an Regional Alternate on the Libertarian National Committee and Treasurer of the Libertarian Party of Nevada. He has run for public office as a Libertarian several times.

Tim joined the Order of the Golden Shillelagh in 2015 and was inducted into the Academy of Electrical and Computer Engineering in 2018.

Tim is serving as a Chapter President of the Sons of the American Revolution.
